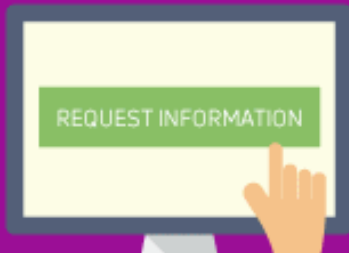


What's the GDPR all about?



The General Data Protection Regulation is a new document, which helps your doctor's surgery keep the information about you safe.

People who look after your information are called data controllers and the people who use your data are called data processors.



You can ask to see the information we hold about you at any time. If you're under 16 but over 12, you may be able to do this yourself.

If you are under the age of 16, parental consent is required for the purposes of using online services. This will be reduced to 13 under the Data Protection Act 2018.
